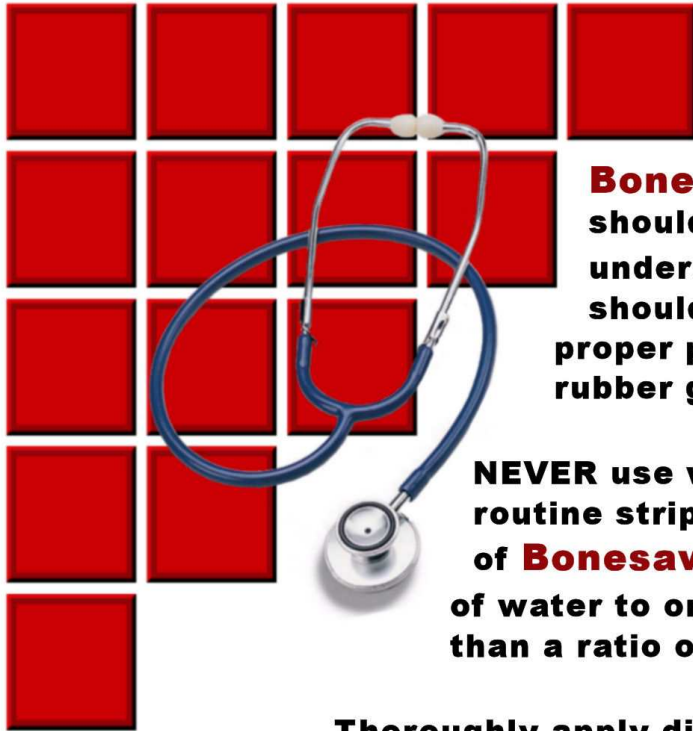


# Bonesaw

## Stripper Concentrate



**Directions For Use:**  
**IMPORTANT! READ THE LABEL FIRST!**

**Bonesaw** is a powerful floor finish stripper that should only be used after you and your crew understand this label. Full strength **Bonesaw** should never be allowed to contact skin. Wear proper protective gear, including safety goggles, rubber gloves, and waterproof shoes or boots.

**NEVER** use without diluting **Bonesaw** with water. For routine stripping, mix 30 gallons of water to 1 gallon of **Bonesaw**. For heavy-duty stripping, mix 15 gallons of water to one gallon of **Bonesaw**. Never mix stronger than a ratio of 15:1 with this product.

Thoroughly apply diluted **Bonesaw** to work area. Allow to soak for 5 to 10 minutes. Do NOT allow stripper to dry on floor. Machine strip, then remove all soiled solution with auto-scrubber or wet vac. Rinse with clean water and **Therapy** neutral cleaner. Floor is ready to recoat with any **FloorCareMD** finish when completely dry.

### First Aid

**For eye contact:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing.

**For contact with skin or clothing:** Immediately flush skin with plenty of water while removing contaminated clothing or footwear. See a physician for further treatment advice. Wash clothing thoroughly before reuse.

**For inhalation:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial resuscitation, preferably mouth to mouth. Call a doctor for further treatment advice.

**For Ingestion:** DO NOT induce vomiting. Drink one cup of water as soon as possible to rinse throat. Immediately call poison control or doctor for treatment advice. DO NOT give anything by mouth if unconscious.
